I am for HB 4134, also known as “1.25% for Wildlife.” This bill would create a dedicated, long-term funding source to protect and restore imperiled fish, wildlife, and habitats across the state by modestly increasing the state transient lodging tax. For the high desert, this could mean real, sustained investment in sagebrush-steppe restoration, wildlife connectivity, invasive species control, and wildfire resilience—work that is essential to keeping these ecosystems whole and thriving.
