

To the House Committee on Behavioral Health,

My name is Olivia Bormann and I am a Clinical Social Work Associate in Oregon. I oppose HB 4083 as written.

In the Behavioral Health Talent Council meeting held on Thursday, January 29th, 2026, the Governor's Office reported they are drafting an amendment to remove the section of the bill that moves the BLSW into MHRA. I have included the slide from the presentation below.
