Speaking as a landlord I see plenty of room for trouble should this legislation pass.

- 1,200 watts is a rather insignificant amount but it can still cause a fire if improperly put in service.
- Simply because filing a declaration with the utility is required doesn't mean it will be.
- Most importantly, in keeping with the Oregon legislature's war against tax payers providing rental homes to those in need, it removes yet another right we ought to have in the handling of our own property.

I am very much against this legislation but from previous examples of our legislation hold little hope it will be tabled.
