What the bill does

HB 4134 would add a modest 1.25% increase to Oregon's state transient lodging tax, with funds dedicated specifically to wildlife conservation and coexistence efforts, including:

- Reducing and prioritizing nonlethal remedies to wildlife conflict
- Strengthening anti-poaching enforcement
- Supporting habitat connectivity and restoration
- Investing in programs that benefit both wildlife and communities

Importantly, 65% of this tax is paid by out-of-state visitors, not Oregonians—and Oregon would still rank among the lowest lodging tax states in the country.
