I am an Oregon resident from Salem who worked hard for the passage of Ballot Measure 114. I specifically worked with churches in the Salem area to gather signatures in order to get the gun safety measure before the voters. I, like many others who supported Measure 114, wanted to see it implemented soon after passage by the voters. Instead, it has been tied up in court appeals for several years. It seems likely that the measure will finally be approved by the Oregon Supreme Court in a matter of months.

We need to reduce gun violence and Measure 114's ban on large capacity magazines, closing the Charleston loophole, and the permit to purchase requirement need to be in effect as soon as possible. HB 4145 will make the implementation of those requirements more efficient and effective. Please pass HB 4145 this Session!
