Chair and Members of the Senate Committee on Judiciary,

My name is David Hatch, and I am writing in opposition to SB 1583.

SB 1583 would destabilize systems of care built under Measure 110 by shifting oversight and funding in ways that disrupt treatment, recovery, harm reduction, and deflection services. These systems are the result of years of work by providers and communities to build capacity, coordination, and trust.

Major structural changes risk creating gaps in care and leaving people without consistent access to services. Oregon should focus on strengthening existing programs and improving coordination—not introducing instability through governance changes.

I urge you to oppose SB 1583. Thank you for considering my testimony.
