Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB1583

Chair and Members of the Senate Committee on Judiciary,

I am submitting testimony in opposition to SB 1583. The proposed changes would undermine the systems of care established under Measure 110 by shifting oversight and funding in ways that disrupt treatment, recovery, harm reduction, and deflection services across the state.

Communities and providers have invested years into building trust, capacity, and continuity of care. Sudden structural changes jeopardize that progress, making it harder for people to access consistent support and increasing the risk of service gaps for those who rely on them most.

Oregon's focus should remain on strengthening and refining the programs already in place, improving data systems, and supporting the workforce — not introducing instability through major governance changes. For these reasons, I respectfully urge you to oppose SB 1583.
