This bill does not follow current evidence and ethics. Many hospitals and clinics ceased sex rejecting procedures because of the science and not legalities.

Adolescents identify with their biological sex after going through puberty. There are significant long term consequences with sex rejecting procedures; such as, infertility, cardiovascular neurological, muscular skeletal diseases, urinary complications, and much more. These children become medical patients for life. Those with gender dysphoria have a high incidence of mental health issues, autism spectrum disorder, and troubled family dynamics.
