Chair Kropf, Vice-Chair Chotzen, Vice-Chair Wallan, members of the House Committee on Judiciary,

Measure 114 reflects the will of voters who want a system that prioritizes safety, accountability, and common-sense standards. By strengthening oversight and establishing clearer expectations, this measure helps ensure that our laws work as intended—to prevent harm before it happens rather than responding after tragedy has already occurred.

HB 4145 builds on these goals by addressing gaps in existing law and improving enforcement and implementation. Together, these measures provide practical tools for reducing violence, supporting responsible behavior, and giving law enforcement and communities clearer guidance. Importantly, they focus on prevention and responsibility, not punishment for its own sake.

Communities across our state are asking for action that is measured, evidence-based, and focused on protecting lives. HB 4145 answers that call. They acknowledge that public safety and individual rights are not mutually exclusive, and that smart policy can honor both.
