My Name is Jennifer Wunder and I am a COMMUNITY MEMBER and landowner of 80 acres, who plans who to open a FARM STAND OPERATOR in Sixes with my family! I am writing to you today to express my opposition to HB 4153. Farm stands are a vital part of connecting the public with our food system and building an understanding of what it takes to go from field to fork. But HB 4153 would restrict who is allowed to have a farm stand, replace current definitions with Farm Stores, and give large land owners privileges at the expense of small farm stands in Oregon. We need to find a better solution.

I care about this because:

I frequently go to a farm stand that would not meet the acreage requirements in section 2.2 of the bill.

Small farms need to have the same opportunities to sell their produce as larger farms.

Small farming important to you because these Farmers are members of my community and currently have existing Farm Stands that would be eliminated if this passed. They have CANNOT AFFORD to expand their farm; EVEN OF they could afford expanding the required acreage as suggested to operate, their current owners are not just going to annex them part of their property!
