I am writing to respectfully express my opposition to HB 4145 currently under consideration in the Oregon Legislature.

After reviewing the bill, I am concerned that HB 4145 would create unintended consequences that could negatively impact Oregonians without delivering clear, measurable benefits. As written, the proposal appears to expand regulatory or governmental involvement in ways that may increase costs, limit individual or local decision-making, and add administrative complexity without sufficient justification.
