Masked, unidentified, heavily armed individuals are violently abusing our communities and routinely violating constitutional rights. Because they conceal their identities, there is no way to determine whether they are federal agents or imposters, especially since impersonation of law enforcement is both easy and documented. This lack of transparency is egregious, chaotic, and deeply alarming. The violence carried out by armed, masked men, emboldened by anonymity, has severely eroded trust in both local and federal institutions.

Allowing this to continue without accountability endangers community members, including young children, and also puts legitimate agents at risk of being mistaken for criminals. When individuals cannot be identified, unlawful violence goes unpunished. This is terrifying at best, and fatal at worst.
