Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB4145

I, John Edward Le Tourneux IV, vehemently oppose the proposed bill, for the reasons that it subjects working people who wish to use their handguns for sport in designated areas, and that this bill further widens the gulf between our civilian LEOs and our civilians who are not currently working as peace officers.

The militarization of civilian police at the state, county, and federal levels should be discouraged.

If exemptions to any proposed  $\geq 10$  round handgun be allowed, it would be acceptable only to military personnel, to civilians, whether they be designated by state, county, municipality, or the federal government.

In the state of Oregon, I believe it is correct to oppose HB 4145.
