Therefore, I oppose HB 4088 because it is muddled, irresponsible, and will result in harm to women and children. For example, provisions easing name/sex changes in the name of privacy could undermine single-sex spaces like women's shelters, prisons, and sports by enabling unchecked legal recognition of gender identity, contributing to the erasure of sex distinctions and compelled speech concerns.
