I believe this legislation would undermine our autonomy and limit our ability to make personal choices. If passed, the bill would not adequately reflect the diverse needs of our community. I am personally opposing SB 1505, as I noticed that when the bill was introduced, individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities were not included in the process. The proposed representation on the relevant board does not accurately represent the diversity of our community. If this bill is enacted, it could lead to decisions that are not in the best interest of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities. DON't PASS SENATE BILL 1505.
