I am submitting this testimony in strong support of HB 4134 with the -1 amendment to increase the state lodging tax by 1.25% and help recover Oregon's most vulnerable fish, wildlife, and habitats. I have lived, paid taxes, and worked in natural resources/wildlife research, conservation, and management in Oregon for over 50 years. HB4134 is one of the smartest and obvious wins for conservation that ties individual human activity with a small but significant conservation responsibility where it counts - in the coffers to protect and sustain Oregon's incredible array of wildlife and the ecological diversity Oregon wildlife depends on and we Oregonians are so proud of.

Humans have been and will continue to be one of the largest indelible impacts on the natural world and we must responsibly balance our negative actions with positive ones through actions such as passing HB 4134. Our thriving tourism economy depends on thriving fish and wildlife populations and the habitats that support them. On an individual basis, visitors are unlikely to notice their small contribution and are more likely to commend it if they do notice.
