I'm writing in opposition to SB 1583. This bill would disrupt the systems of care that were built under Measure 110 by shifting oversight and funding in ways that create instability for treatment, recovery, harm reduction, and deflection services.

Providers and communities have spent years building these programs and earning trust. Making abrupt structural changes now would make it harder to provide consistent care and could leave people without the services they rely on.

Instead of destabilizing what's already in place, Oregon should focus on strengthening existing programs and improving data systems. I urge you to oppose SB 1583.
