I oppose HB 4143

This bill directly violates:

The Supremacy Clause (U.S. Const. art. VI, cl. 2):

This Constitution, and the Laws of the United States which shall be made in Pursuance thereof; and all Treaties made, or which shall be made, under the Authority of the United States, shall be the supreme Law of the Land; and the Judges in every State shall be bound thereby, any Thing in the Constitution or Laws of any State to the Contrary notwithstanding.

The clause binds state officials and courts to uphold federal law, reinforcing national unity while preserving federalism (states retain powers not delegated to the federal government).

A vindictive policy against the federal government could have consequences affecting all Oregonians. It will only make the state worse off.
