Chair and Members of the Senate Committee on the Judiciary,

I am writing in opposition to SB 1583. Over the past several years, providers and communities across Oregon have worked hard to build systems of care under Measure 110. Those efforts have taken time, trust, and real investment. SB 1583 would undermine that progress by shifting oversight and funding in ways that could disrupt treatment, recovery, harm reduction, and deflection services that people are relying on right now. Sudden structural changes like this make it harder for providers to deliver consistent, effective care and increase the risk that people will fall through the cracks. At a time when stability and continuity are critical, this bill introduces uncertainty into systems that are still being strengthened.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge you to oppose SB 1583. Thank you for taking the time to consider my testimony.
