I am the owner of a small business, Sharetea, located at 1260 East Burnside Street in Portland. We serve smoothies, boba milk tea, coffee, and fruit teas to our local community.

I import most of my products from Taiwan, and over the past year my costs have increased 30% due to tariffs. These rising expenses have placed significant strain on our operating budget. As a result, I have been forced to raise prices, reduce store hours and employee hours, and remove items from our menu because I can no longer afford the inventory required to produce them.


In the six years I have proudly operated this business, this is the first time that I have truly struggled with the decision of whether I can keep my doors open.

The Tariff Adjustment Grants would be a critical lifeline, helping small businesses like mine remain open, retain employees, and continue serving our communities.
