My name is Michelle Groce. I am a resident of House District 27 and a Beaverton School District parent. I am writing to urge your support of HB4125, to modernize the kicker.

Oregon's current tax procedures are, frankly, bizarre. You tax Oregon residents, refund a large portion of that tax, and then make massive cuts to essential government programs and services because of lack of funding. It sure seems like the supposed "surplus" being refunded to taxpayers through the kicker is not actually surplus funding, but in fact desperately needed for the state budget.

Insult is piled on top of injury when taxpayers are asked if they want to "donate" their kicker to fund K-12 education. The whole concept of taxation is that we all ought to chip in to fund the programs that benefit our entire society!
