Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB4145

I oppose this bill in it's entirety, for a multitude of reasons. It is clearly flawed, and infringes on the constitutional rights of all law-abiding Oregonians.

It doubles the processing time and significantly increases the permit to purchase fee from \$65 to \$150, which is unreasonable at best. This is an unnecessary burden for law-abiding citizens in order to exercise a protected right under the Constitution and the State Constitution. 4145 will specifically cause extended delays in being able to exercise that protected right, effectively denying it.

It also creates a protected class of individuals, from being bound by the requirements as set forth in 4145, which is totally unacceptable.
