"I am an Oregon resident who voted for Measure 114. I wanted it implemented immediately, and the delay due to the Courts has been frustrating. We need to reduce gun violence, and Measure 114 should be in effect now. Even though Portland's murder rate went down in 2025, it is still much higher than it was prior to 2000.
