This bill serves only to do two things.

Make it harder for minority and underprivileged group to exercise their rights, and further create the identity of "law enforcement officer" as a privileged class who has rights above those of the common man.

Measure 114 is not even in effect yet and this bill already seeks to increase the cost for us to be able to purchase and operate firearms.
