I am a retired combat veteran. I have an MBA from Willamette. I taught at North Salem High School and had a NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PRECISION AIR RIFLE TEAM, with Title 1 HS schools, in a school that has to compete at the 5A level because they lose at everything. WE WON. I am also a NRA and USCCA Certified Firearms Instructor, Army Master Gunner, and LEADER.
