Dear Co-Chairs Pham, Nathanson and Members of the Joint Information Management and Technology Committee,

My name is Stephanie Rhoades and I am writing on behalf of Women's Care to request your support of HB 4054.

HB 4054 adds the necessary transparency to prevent insurers from adjusting claims without appropriate review of visits. The staff costs required to track and appeal the downcoding is unnecessary and adds a layer of burden to the healthcare providers.

We are advocating to get paid for the services that Women's Care is providing and cannot afford to lose or have delayed payment for services that have already been provided.

We are asking for transparency when AI is being used, when downcoding or underpaying our claims occurs and for clear appeal processes to be communicated. The current lack of transparency results in staff time in excess of 30 hours/month, when we already invest in and employ certified coders to review each of the claims prior to submission.

We respectfully urge your support in HB 4054.
