My name is Michelle Hsu, and I am a member of the Linn Benton Lincoln Health
Equity Alliance. I am writing in strong support of HB 4138.

When law enforcement officers operate while masked or without clear identification, it
becomes difficult for the public to know who is acting in our communities, whether
they are legitimate officers, and whether their actions are lawful. This lack of
transparency undermines trust and raises serious concerns about accountability.
HB 4138 strengthens public trust by requiring all law enforcement officers operating
in Oregon to clearly identify themselves, who they work for, and to be visible to the
public. The bill also helps protect civil rights by maintaining appropriate boundaries
between state and local employees and federal enforcement activities.
