Right now, if someone violates our Fourth Amendment protection against unreasonable searches, it seems there is no way to hold them accountable. I just have to eat the damage these people do to my property. It's no wonder property values are going down, we are unable to protect our own homes from these lawless animals.

This bill changes that. It says: If you violate someone's constitutional rights, you can be sued personally. You'll pay actual damages, a minimum of \$1,000, and the person's attorney fees. The Fourth Amendment protects us. HB 4114 makes sure we can enforce that protection. As a law-abiding US citizen who has always contributed to my country, I urge you to vote yes on this measure, and help keep our properties safe homes.
