The Law Enforcement Accountability and Visibility Act (LEAVA) addresses the important public safety issue of masked law enforcement. This bill also protects Oregonians from potential federal law enforcement abuses by drawing clear lines between local/state and federal law enforcement activities and creating greater transparency when joint operations occur. It also prohibits any state/local government employee from cooperating with federal or other out-of-state attacks on free speech or other lawfully protected communities.

At a time when unprecedeted numbers of ICE and other federal agents are harassing and terrorizing people and communities across our state and country, accountability and visibility for all law enforcement across Oregon are needed more than ever.
