My name is Micah Meskel and I live in Milwaukie, Oregon. I am submitting this testimony in support of HB 4134 with the -1 amendment.

I believe it is completely appropriate to increase the state lodging tax by 1.25% to help recover Oregon's most vulnerable fish, wildlife, and habitats. The funding would not only help wildlife and habitats, but also support local communities and businesses that rely on tourism dollars as it will help protect and steward the public resource that draws so many tourists to our state. Oregon's robust outdoor tourism economy supports nearly 200,000 jobs and brings in \$16 billion in consumer spending.
