HB4114

I oppose advancing HB 4114. It incorporates a loose, non-judicial, non-legal interpretation of "reasonable expectation of privacy" locations and seeks to outlaw even tactical officer safety assistance with fed'l agencies unless a civilian employee with the state's DOJ is notified in advance. This premise is unsafe, unrealistic, & ridiculous. Current guidelines re: presence/entrance announcements are guided by operational plans, existing polices/rules, & current laws applicable to whichever agency is the primary investigative agency in the particular case. This bill & its supporters seek to legislate policies, uniform standards, & lawful practices of agencies outside of this legislature's jurisdiction. Instead of falling into the gullible trap of anti-POTUS sentiment fomented by a very noisy few, legislative members from both sides of the political aisle should better spend their efforts crafting meaningful & effective legislation which will result in encouraging compliance with all laws by the citizenry.
