Like most Americans, I support a HUMANE border policy that ensures people are treated with respect and dignity. Entering the United States without proper process is a CIVIL violation – not a criminal one. It should be treated as such.

The siege of ICE agents on our communities is preventing people from seeking medical care. The pattern of violence, intimidation, and harassment is forcing many Oregonians to delay or skip necessary healthcare; turning treatable conditions into life-threatening emergencies that harm the patient, the system and community far more than necessary.
