My Name is Carin Hilgeman and I am a COMMUNITY MEMBER in TOWN. I am writing to you today to express my opposition to HB 4153. Farm stands are a vital part of connecting the public with our food system and building an understanding of what it takes to go from field to fork. But HB 4153 would restrict who is allowed to have a farm stand, replace current definitions with Farm Stores, and give large land owners privileges at the expense of small farm stands in Oregon. We need to find a better solution.

I care about this because access to local, fresh, chemical free food in such a remote place on the Oregon Coast is so unbelievably important to me, my family and my community. I get fresh produce from the Valley Flora farm stand, they supply produce to the co-op where I shop and to many restaurants in the area where I eat.

We are asking you to not place a higher burden on the smallest farms. This bill takes away opportunities from small land holders and farms in order for larger operations to be able to host more events. This is not a good bargain for Oregon and a better deal must be found.
