My name is Tammy Carpenter and I serve on the Beaverton School Board. I am writing to you today on my own behalf, strongly encouraging you to vote YES on HB 4114, Representative Munoz's Protect Your Door Act.

Immigrant Oregonians, regardless of status, have been targeted by violent, lawless ICE sweeps resulting in hospitalizations, devastating family separations, violations of the U.S. Constitution, and killings.

These horrific and unconstitutional federal attacks demand a strong, unified response. Federal immigration agents cannot enter private homes without a judge-signed warrant.

Does anyone recall the 4th Amendment?

Our home is sacred. The law is the law. These authoritarian and fascist violations of our most fundamental constitutional rights will continue if we do not take a stand here and now. Freedom of speech, the right to due process, the right to vote? We are at risk of losing all of this and more under this current administration. States like Oregon must act NOW.

HB 4114 would hold individuals personally responsible for unlawful home entries, giving families in immigrant communities the ability to sue for damages and harm caused. This accountability, this deterrent, this enforceability, matters.

The Protect Your Door Act strengthens our constitutional right to be secure in our own homes. I support this legislation and the entire 2026 Immigrant Justice Package. Listen to those who are in danger right now asking for help. Stand up and protect Oregon.
