Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB4054

- This bill adds much needed transparency to the emerging issue of downcoding. Downcoding happens when a provider treats a patient and submits a claim for reimbursement, and the health insurer reimburses them at a lower-level code.
- Recently, some insurers have started to downcode large batches of claims using artificial intelligence technology.
- The lack of transparency around this process and technology makes it difficult for clinics to track when claims have been downcoded.
- I respectfully urge your support of HB 4054. This bill does not ban the use of AI, it simply adds much needed transparency to this emerging technology. Insurance companies should have to provide the methods and evidence when downcoding.
- Downcoding should only be on review of an individual case, not done in large batches to match insurance company statistics.
- Coding and billing are already a large cost for practices. Having to appeal downcoding based on AI will only add time and expense.
