Dear Chair Golden, and Members of the Senate Natural Resources Committee,

My name is Ed Glennon, I live in Portland, and I strongly support SB 1541, to create a Climate Resilience Superfund. This legislation would hold polluters accountable by having large fossil fuel companies pay their fair share of the climate-related costs Oregonians are on the hook for.
