Restoring the validity of liability waivers for ordinary negligence is a practical step that would bring Oregon in line with surrounding states. Today, Oregon businesses in recreation and fitness face higher liability insurance costs because waivers cannot be relied upon as a standard risk-management tool. These higher premiums ultimately translate to increased consumer costs, reduced access to programs, or in some cases, the loss of recreational opportunities altogether.

For communities like Tigard where parks, trails, sports programming, and community events are integral to quality of life and local economic vitality this issue has both economic and social impacts. Recreation businesses are part of the broader ecosystem that supports tourism, family activities, youth development, and small business entrepreneurship. Providing a more predictable legal environment allows these businesses to operate responsibly while continuing to serve the public.

SB 1593 does not eliminate accountability; rather, it places Oregon on equal footing with other states by allowing reasonable, clearly communicated liability waivers to function as intended. This change supports responsible business operations while helping stabilize insurance costs and preserve recreational options for Oregonians.
