Oregon's registered voters sent a clear message to Tina Kotek and the supporters of HB 3991 when we jointly collected and submitted 250,000 signatures in December to refer the controversial transportation tax increases to the November ballot.

Voters are pushing back against extreme officials—from the governor down. We're fed up and reclaiming our state. We've lost faith that those in power are listening; instead they act on their own agenda rather than the will of the people.
