If the people of Oregon wish to have the transportation bill put into effect, it should be put into effect as soon as possible. There are critical needs at hand!

A six-month delay in road work, for example -- which would occur if the bill is voter-approved in November, rather than in May -- will be inconvenient, if not dangerous, to the users of Oregon's roads.
