I don't feel like the elected democrat super majority really understands what it means to listen to their constituents! I personally collected signatures to put the Referendum on the ballot in NOVEMBER 2026. Primary elections historically have significantly lower turnout than general elections (often 30-40% vs. 70-80%+ in Nov). Moving the ballot to a primary in May would likely reduce broad voter input that singers expected in a November vote. I believe this is a deliberate strategy to limit participation, especially since the November ballot would coincide with other races, including the governor's race. I vehemently OPPOSE SB1599.
