Primary elections historically have significantly lower turnout than general elections (often 30-40% vs. 70-80%+ in Nov). My concern about moving the ballot to a primary in May is that it would likely reduce broad voter input that singers expected in a November vote. I believe this is a deliberate strategy to limit participation, especially since the November ballot would coincide with other races, including the governor's race. I OPPOSE SB1599.
