

**I STRONGLY OPPOSE SB 1599. I AM STRONGLY OPPOSED TO MOVING REFERENDUM PETITION 2026-302 TO THE PRIMARY ELECTION MAY 19, 2026, IT NEEDS TO BE PART OF THE NOVEMBER 2026 GENERAL ELECTION AS ORIGINALLY INTENDED.**
