I strongly oppose this bill as it gives unlimited authority to unelected public health officials to intervene in personal health decisions and impose medical mandates against individuals consent.

It's particularly disturbing to see that this bill is sponsored by a legislator who wanted to "force vaccines, make it a prerequisite for indoor dining, working in the office and furthering the education" during the Covid19 pandemic.

According to the bill, "Public Health Officer may issue evidence-based recommendations for immunizations." "May issue" does not mean "have to" which should be an absolute requirement for any medical interventions.

Shall Oregonians be prepared for another run of medical experiments of untested vaccines? Such medical tyranny should have no place in our society.

There is absolutely no emergency for this bill which has been drafted in response to October 2025 CDC recommendations to apply "individual-based decision-making" to COVID-19 vaccination.
