Forced Compliance: Invokes statewide one-size-fits-all medical orders without individual consent.

Taxpayer-Funded Mandates: Compels insurances companies and taxpayer-supported public programs to pay in full for vaccines and health services.

Overrides Doctors: Removes ability of doctors to make decisions in the best interest of their patients.

Strongly opposed to SB1598.
