

Subject: Vote NO on SB 1599 — Respect Oregon Voters

Chair and Members of the Committee,

I represent a newly formed Wasco County PAC. Our mission is to increase the word and get it out to the voters of all parties when public leaders attempt to derail Oregonians policy desires. The current effort on the recently written SB1599 is designed to eliminate a large part of the voting rights of Oregonians. This is truly irresponsible leadership. I'm writing to strongly urge you to vote NO on SB 1599.
