#### Testimony AGAINST Senate Bill 1599

Over the past 6 months, I've watched our elected officials in Salem work to disenfranchise the hard-working tax-paying Oregonians who elected them. The "emergency" session called by the Governor over labor-day weekend to finalize this pork-heavy tax, the several week delay in "voting" on this bill, as a key democratic legislator was recovering from surgery. The governor waiting till the last minute to sign the bill, reducing the time opponents would have to mount a recall petition.

But the people of Oregon did mount a recall petition... One if not the most successful in Oregon's history. Almost 250,000 signatures were collected and the Secretary of State verified that the referendum qualified. As stated on the petition, this referendum would appear on the November 2026 ballot.

Now our democratic "leadership" (sarcasm) wants to refer this to the May election, so that this referendum would not be on the same ballot as the democrat Governor candidate and may not pass given lower voter turnout during a minor election. SB 1599 was also declared as an "EMERGENCY" but will not take affect until 2028. If this is an emergency, why the 2 year delay?

These actions amplify what many in Oregon are feeling. Ever increasing taxes focusing on democratic priorities which don't align with many Oregonian's values. Representative Government is supposed to represent the will of the constituents, the voters, not the will of elected officials who seem to be driving their own agenda. My trust in the state government is VERY low, as it appears as though our legislature's actions are driving their agenda and NOT looking after the best interests of taxpayers in the state.

This has got to stop. If it continues, we will no longer have a state. I hope and pray that this is NOT the desired end-state of our legislatures.
