Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB1598

I oppose granting broad power to unelected public health officials to make decisions that affect all of us. This would be unchecked authority without public debate.

I oppose automatic mandates that clear the way for vaccine requirements that affect our children's access to schools.

I oppose invoking statewide one-size-fits-all medical orders without individual consent. In other words, I oppose forced compliance.
