The benefits are too great not to support SB 1501. The Blazers are one of the largest contributors in supporting a strong Portland and a strong state.

The Rose Quarter brings over \$600 million per year in economic activity to the greater Portland area, over 75% is directly related to the 41+ home games the Blazers play at MODA each year. Through playing in Portland, the franchise supports thousands of jobs and provides over \$290 million a year in salaries. In turn, those salaries are spent throughout the city and state, further supporting the Oregon economy.

Beyond the obvious immediate impacts, the Blazers help provide a national stage to showcase Oregon and our great state. It provides the lens through which fans can experience our rich culinary scene, world class pinot and chardonnays, and quirky Portland identity. It provides an updated MODA that brings in bigger concerts, shows, and places Portland at the top of performers' venue lists.

The Blazers are also huge contributors to Portland and the State. Since 2009, the Blazers have awarded over \$17 million in grants, over \$2 million in 2025 alone.
