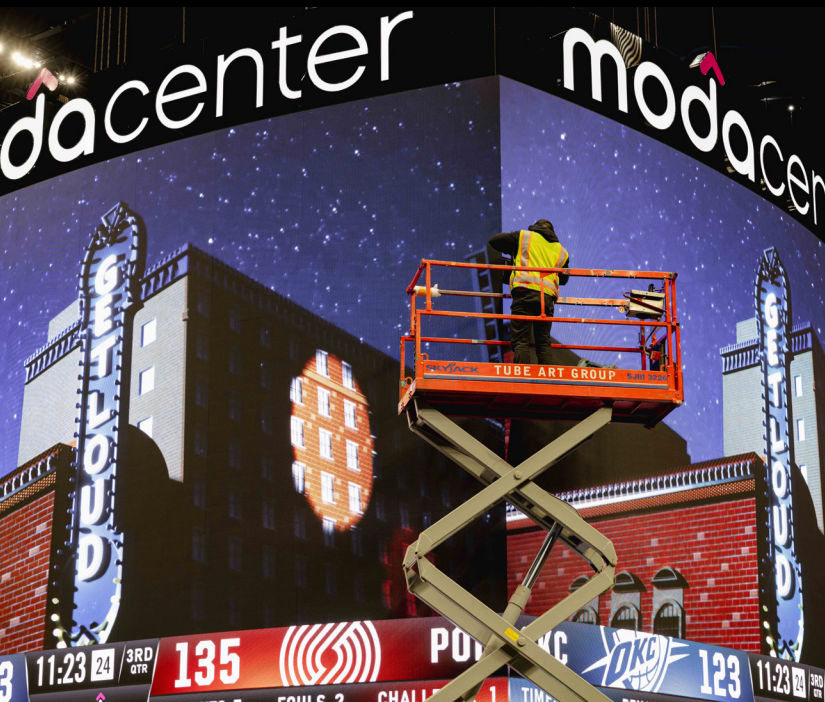

IMPACT ON THE CENTRAL CITY

Moda Center attracts 1.6 million visitors each year, fueling \$113 million in visitor economic impact, benefiting Portland's lodging, dining, retail, and transportation sectors.

- 64% OF ROSE QUARTER VISITORS COME DIRECTLY FROM A LOCATION OTHER THAN THEIR HOME OR WORK.
- 40% OF ROSE QUARTER VISITORS GO DIRECTLY TO ANOTHER ESTABLISHMENT AFTER THEIR VISIT.
