As our voice in Salem, we are counting on you to reject some of the most egregious
and costly tax breaks for corporations and the wealthy and prevent cuts to public
safety, schools, childcare, and other critical services. That begins with voting yes on
SB 1507.

SB 1507 helps recoup \$311.6 million in funding for programs Oregonians care about
by "disconnecting" Oregon from automatically mirroring some of the most costly tax
loopholes in H.R. 1, the disastrous budget bill signed by President Trump.

To be clear, there is more work to do beyond SB 1507. There is still a larger budget
gap to close, and balancing the budget by slashing programs Oregonians rely on is
the wrong approach. But one thing is certain: passing SB 1507 is a critical first step in
addressing the budget crisis created by H.R. 1.
